

MyBlood Charitable Blood Bank, a vital initiative of Mahesh Foundation, has been at the forefront of life-saving efforts through a series of impactful blood donation camps. With compassionate donors stepping forward, over 200 units of blood were collected in recent drives, potentially saving the lives of more than 600 patients in need of urgent transfusions.

Several successful collaborations made these drives possible. In partnership with IP Nagar Residents, a blood donation camp inspired the local community to engage in this life-saving mission. Similarly, on Republic Day, a camp organized in collaboration with B.S. Channabasappa & Sons. Another remarkable initiative, held at Belagavi Airport in partnership with the Airport Authority of Belagavi.


