Most of the HIV-positive and underprivileged children's families are of low socioeconomic backgrounds, they don't have access to proper food and other facilities and are at a greater risk of hunger, sickness, physical and mental disabilities, and violence. They don't go to school which makes them illiterate and suffer from various issues. The effect of undernutrition on children can be devastating and enduring.

It is essential to provide a balanced diet to these children which would in turn enable the children to increase their attention span hence better academic achievement. The Feeding Program is a crucial component in the development of holistic children. Nutrition and health are powerful influences on a children's learning and how well the children perform in school. Healthy children will concentrate more on class work hence developing the cognitive part. They can also play to develop physically and will interact with others with a lot of ease and grow in self-esteem.

Daily Feeding program contribute to the education and well-being of children. A hungry child does not grow, cannot learn as well and faces many health risks in the future. Daily Feeding Program can bring children into school and out of hunger. It is far more than food-giving.

Srushti is a 13-year-old child who resides at Mahesh Foundation's Ashakiran care home. Srushti's parents left this world due to the deadly disease they were suffering from. There was no one to take care of this child after her parent's demise. Literally, she suffered a lot due to her health condition and poverty, the situation has made her so weak and helpless. As you know, HIV-infected people need more care and support but in the case of Srushti, it was very difficult as she was abandoned by her relatives and society.

Day by day her health condition became worse due to the unavailability of proper food and nutrition and she faced lots of health issues. Srusthi was enrolled in Ashakiran care home, at the time of enrollment her condition was critical, our care home environment and proper care changed her condition to normal. She found her new family in Mahesh Foundation and started living a healthy and happy life. But maintaining the health condition of HIV-infected children is a bit difficult as they have low immune power and require special care and mainly healthy nutritional food. And they should be protected from malnutrition.

It was a bit difficult for us to manage the right nutrition level of HIV-infected children like Srushti who are residing at our care home because they need well-balanced and proper food at the right time. Feeding India gave a solution to our challenge and joined their helping hands with us and supported us to provide nutritional and healthy meals to children like Srushti. Now Srushti enjoys the healthy food provided by feeding India and leading a healthy and happy life.

Impact

13-year-old Ganesh is an HIV-positive kid and was brought to Mahesh Foundation as he was lacking proper care and support. He lost his mother due to her illness and this has badly affected his growth and development. Even though he has a father, poverty made the kid suffer from illness and malnutrition. His father was unable to take care of the kid because of poverty and lack of support.

The kid was brought to Mahesh Foundation and was enrolled in the Ashakiran care home. When he was brought to us his health condition was very poor due to improper food and medication. After a few days, we managed to change his condition. HIV-positive kids need extra care, mainly the proper nutritional food so that the food can help the child to get sufficient energy to tackle the health issues and to survive a healthy life.

Earlier the number of children residing at our care home was lesser but gradually the number started increasing and it was very challenging for us to manage all the needs of children along with proper nutritional food. Feeding India came forward to support us and provide nutritional food to the children. Now hundreds of kids like Ganesh are getting well-balanced food and are free from malnutrition and hunger.





Just like this child, Feeding India has made a greater impact on hundreds of children residing at Mahesh Foundation's care home, children studying at Utkarsha Learning Center and the children who are getting supplementary education under community program. With the continued support of Feeding India, we aim to benefit more children in the coming days.

Children's Academic Results.

We announced the results of the children and discussed their progress report with the children's parents and suggested necessary guidelines to the parents to improve children's performances.







Entrance exams for new admission.

Utkarsha School started the admission process for the academic year 2023-2024. As part of this Utkarsha Learning Center conducted the entrance exams for the admission applicants. The main purpose of conducting the entrance exam is to judge the children's ability, sharpness, knowledge etc. The aptitude of the student is tested in the entrance exam and the children who will pass the entrance exams will be given priority for admission.

In the coming academic year, we at Utkarsha aim to enroll 300+ underprivileged students, increasing the strength of the school from 175 to 475. Since the school is for needy children, we ensure the benefits of this school should reach the right needy. As a part of this, our team visited the families of these underprivileged children for the background screening process. After the clear verification of the children's family background, we shortlist the children's names and proceed with the final admission process.

Utkarsha Learning Center has started a new process, as a part of this the teacher's team visited the children's families to verify their backgrounds. This process will help to reach the right needy person. Our aim is to provide quality education to needy children so that they can achieve their goals and accomplish their dreams.

These children are enjoying the snacks provided by Feeding India, all of them are very happy with this initiative.
