

In the year 2022 - 2023, Mahesh Foundation has extended several programs in order to provide a dignified life for underprivileged children, women, and people. From the initial days to till date, it has impacted the lives of thousands of needy and set an example by establishing such wonderful separate care homes for medically challenged children. From giving shelter to one child to giving shelter to hundreds of medically challenged children the journey was full of challenges and obstacles but we succeeded to tackle them and providing a peaceful and healthy life to the needy.

Mahesh Foundation's Utkarsha Learning Center has been helping hundreds of underprivileged children to get the best quality education, meal, digital education and providing safe transportation facilities for the children. The children who have remained away from education are provided a platform for their bright future. The school has the best skill-based classrooms, computer classrooms and digital education facilities which enable underprivileged children to explore beyond basic learning skills. Currently, 275+ children are benefited from Utkarsha school. Under Aadhar Vidya Program we have been supporting thousands of children to continue their education, we have reached the govt schools and provided school kits to the children. Also proposed new skill center where underprivileged women and girl children will be trained with skills.

Our livelihood and training center is bringing underprivileged women to the mainstream and providing them a platform to earn livelihood. This program has totally changed the conditions of thousands of socially and economically disadvantaged families and all of them are leading a dignified life

Mahesh Foundation started a charitable blood bank called MyBlood charitable blood bank in Kanabargi Belagavi. This blood bank serves the needy free of cost and saves the lives of patients. With this initiative, we intend to eradicate the unavailability of blood and help poor people to access the blood bank facility.

The 100-bed charitable hospital is one of the ambitious projects of Mahesh Foundation which will provide free healthcare service to people belonging to vulnerable communities. Also, we started working on our another project New School and Skill Center Building. We are confident of completing this project within a few months in 2023-24 and making it available for the children.

We feel very happy that our service has made a positive impact on thousands of needy and this is the outcome of our journey. We will be happy to extend our service to more people in need in the coming days.

The premises also has medical facilities and counseling services. These are designed to provide children with access to quality healthcare and education they may not otherwise have. There are many activities and programs carried out at Mahesh Foundation premises that are benefiting thousands of beneficiaries.

But a few years ago, it was just a dream for Mahesh Foundation. That dream has become possible for us with the help of a noted architect and Principal Architect of Bhumiputra Shri. Alok Shetty, the chief architect of the premises. Alok Shetty has been associated with Mahesh Foundation for the past 7 years. He supported the construction of Mahesh Foundation school premises, separate girls hostel, Skill center. Also, he is supporting our dream project 100-Bed Charitable Hospital.

Education



Education is the catalyst for social change

With an aim to ensure quality education for underprivileged children, we have established Utkarsha Learning Center. Under the Aadhar Vidya Program we also support the children who lack support and facilities in their schools & families, such poor children are identified and supported with school kits.

Utkarsha Learning Center

A special school for HIV-positive and underprivileged slum children. The school has been functioning for the past 5 years providing free education to these children. The aim of Utkarsha is to ensure a stigma and discrimination-free learning environment for children who are probably not able to get it if we didn't identify and bring them to the school. Currently, it is providing free Skill-Based education to 640+ such children. As part of the curriculum, Utkarsha Learning has adopted Arts & crafts to enhance skills among the children.

School Permission

After several attempts for the registration of Utkarsha school, we got permission in the year 2022. Mahesh Foundation's Utkarsha Learning Center has been registered under Karnataka Education Board in 2022. In the same year, Utkarsha Learning successfully enrolled 640+ children in the first year.

Experimental World

Aadhar Vidya Program

Doubtless, education is the most powerful catalyst for social transformation. But, there is enormous inequality in access to quality education in India, resulting in massive inequality of opportunity for children. Mahesh Foundation aims to make less privileged children self-reliant and lead dignified life in the future. To date, Mahesh Foundation is externally supporting more than 24,000 children to get an education through the community program.

There are lakhs of children around us who lack support from their families to get an education and are dropping out of school. Education is available free of cost in government schools but many children lack support to even get their school equipment. Children need support to cope with the competitive world to have a dignified life.

Mahesh Foundation reaches government schools and provides school bags and school stationery to them as well as free skills-based and personality development education to the children. Under this initiative, Mahesh Foundation also provides skills-based education to the children such as computer education, art, drama, sports and others. Many college students work as volunteers and impart their knowledge and skills to the children.

To date we have reached more than 24000 underprivileged children providing education support to help them continue their education. Also, succeeded to bring awareness among their parents.





Aadhar Vidya - Skill-Based Education

Digital education is a must for children to compete in this digital age. Digital education platforms are expensive and out of reach for underprivileged children. In addition, the lack of quality resources widens the divide between children and digital education. We have been providing a platform that enables them to access the digital world and learn more. Every day more than 450 children are benefited from this initiative. We have a dream of making every child proficient in using computers and survive in today's digital world.








A Word of Appreciation

Health and Nutrition



The needs of people living with HIV are great, going far beyond nutritional and health care. They need extra emotional care and psychological support to cope with the implications of having a life-threatening disease, as well as the potential stigma from family and community members. Often, those who suspect or learn that they are HIV-infected feel helpless; they may become depressed and give up hope.

There are thousands of individuals who are suffering from this deadliest HIV and remain away from the mainstream. Mahesh Foundation has been working from the last 15 years to uplift the lives of infected people and to provide a dignified life. Mahesh Foundation's Ashakiran care home & Gokak Care & support center have made an impact on thousands of people living with HIV.







Care Home

The care home that started in a small house has been supporting over 2200 HIV-infected children now. Most of the children in the care home are orphans and were abandoned by their relatives. The care home is providing shelter, nutrition, healthcare, and education to HIV-positive children. From taking care of the children to providing all the facilities to the children this care home takes all the responsibilities of the children. We provide moral support to infected children so that the children can live their life happily. Several programs run by the care home have been benefitting these medically challenged children and brought a positive change among them.

Good Hygiene practices for children

Along with a good education, children should know the importance of good hygiene. Shreya Kapadiya, a volunteer, has voluntarily conducted a session for girl children. She conveyed the importance of personal hygiene and suggested some daily routine personal hygiene tips to lead a healthy life.

World Health Day.

Yoga is one of the best solutions for maintaining good health. On this occasion, the volunteers of the Mahesh Foundation arranged a yoga activity for the children. The children practiced yoga with the guidance of volunteers and learned the importance of yoga and its benefits in their day-to-day life.

Counseling by the CWC team

The CWC team conducted counseling for our children. The team conveyed the importance of health education & overall growth to the children. Also, they interacted with children about the challenges faced by the children and suggested necessary changes.

Life Skills Education Session

Life skills education helps children build confidence in both communication and cooperative and collaborative skills. Dr. Neeta from Miracle Foundation has been conducting several fruitful sessions and helping them to bring out the change in them. She conducted a Life skill education session on HIV awareness, study skills and stress management.

Career guidance & counseling session

Shri. Girish Naganur conducted Career Guidance and Counseling Sessions for our children and took an aptitude test to know children's interests and knowledge about the subjects and suggested the right ways of choosing a useful platform for a bright career.

Gokak Care & Support Center

Educating and assisting people about this deadliest HIV is not an easy task, it requires hard work, patience, and care. To guide and assist the people living with HIV mainly in the rural regions we established our Gokak CSC program through which we are supporting thousands of people living with HIV.

Our Gokak care and support center has been providing healthcare facilities and assistance to access various government programs for infected people and creating awareness about the disease

- Advocacy and awareness program for HIV infected
 - Gokak CSC team conducted an Advocacy and awareness program for the HIV-infected people in Gokak and surrounding areas. The advocacy and awareness program brought awareness about the Community Rights of the HIV-infected people.
- District Administration, Belagavi honored Mahesh Foundation on World AIDS Day observation Mahesh Foundation has been working to provide quality healthcare and bring them to mainstream society. Gokak Care & Support Center has been established with this motive. The team working in this center has been serving 40000+ HIV-positive people in rural areas. Recognizing the humanitarian efforts, the District Administration, Belagavi honored Mahesh Foundation on World AIDS Day observation.
- Review meeting at Gokak CSC

We organized a review meeting for the Gokak CSC team members and discussed the challenges and the response of the initiative and suggested new implementations to reach more people in need.

- Organized Social Group Meeting at Gokak CSC
 - Our peer champions team at Gokak CSC conducted a Social Group Meeting at Gokak ARTC in which they interacted with people about ART adherence which is the most important factor in determining ART treatment success and long-term viral suppression and raised awareness about maintaining proper health and hygiene. With this initiative, we aim to eradicate the misconceptions related to HIV and provide moral support to people living with HIV.

Mahesh Foundation for Community



Empowering women is key to building the future of the nation.

We focus on creating livelihood for women from marginalized communities and providing the needed training and skills to stand up on their feet. Hence, we conduct such sessions to build their capacity and guide them to become self-sustained. As a part of our women empowerment initiative, many teams of SKDRDP visited Mahesh Foundation. We organized sessions for these women to raise the importance of women empowerment, and the responsibilities of parents while raising their children and also introduced our women empowerment initiatives.



Social Responsibilities of Youth

Youths are the weapon to bring transformation in the world. Our motive is to give awareness about their responsibilities and ensure their contribution in building a strong nation. Mr. Mahesh Jadhav, founder of Mahesh Foundation has addressed more than 2000 youth in various institutions to the date. This program is getting a good response as many youths are inspired by the thoughts of Mahesh Foundation and visiting Mahesh Foundation on their exploring visit. The inspired youth are also thinking of doing their bit to the destitute if possible, financially or as volunteers to share their knowledge to children.



Medical Support

Mr. Sunil Singh Rajput belongs to a middle-class family he had taken a truck on loan and used to drive it for earning. He was the sole breadwinner of the family. All the family's responsibility was on his shoulder, all was going smoothly but one day he was diagnosed with mouth cancer which was on 3rd stage. He has stopped working and the family is struggling to survive. Now the income has totally stopped. Mahesh Foundation took the initiative supported him & paid his medical expenses.





Helped the Needy Woman's Treatment

A 46-year-old Mrs. Supriya Paranjape was a resident of the Maratha colony, Tilakwadi, Belagavi. Her health condition became serious and suffered from multiple lifethreatening diseases. She was a working woman but she lost her job during the COVID-19 pandemic. She has no savings to manage her treatment expenses. She has only one daughter who is currently studying Engineering and is unable to afford the treatment expenses. Mahesh Foundation has strived hard to help her recover soon by extending financial support. And provided financial support for her medical expenses.



Education Support

Poor families are unable to afford the huge educational expenses of their children. This is one of the biggest obstacles in society. Komal Jayaram Pawar was a poor girl who lost her father at a young age. Komal was pursuing her 1st year of PUC. Managing all needs and the high educational expenses was not affordable for her mother. This made her think about her further education. Mahesh Foundation supported her to continue her education and paid her college fees.



Daily Feeding Program

Under the Daily Feeding Program, we ensure daily food essentials for single orphans as well as underprivileged children. We have started this program and identified 800 economically backward children's families and provided the ration kits. This will encourage the children to continue their education as the lack of nutrition is becoming a major reason for dropping out. With the right nutrition, we help these families to live up to their potential.




Inspirational Talk



A Ray of Hope for Needy Children

Shridhar was born in a small village called Yaragoppa of Bailhongal taluka of Belagavi district. He was having it all until the diagnosis of a deadly disease. He has two elder brothers and he was living happily with his family. But, at a very young age, Shridhar's mother left this world due to HIV disease. His father is the only hope for all three brothers, as days passed it was observed that his father was getting weak and was finding it difficult to continue with his routine work. Later when he was diagnosed, it was found that he too was infected by the same disease and that resulted in his death after suffering for two years.

Shridhar and his siblings were ignored by their relatives, there is no one left in the family to take care of the children. Due to the unavailability of proper care food, the kids were becoming weaker day by day. The kid's elder brother decided to enroll his both siblings in an orphanage. Shridhar and his brother were brought to Mahesh Foundation and enrolled in the ashakiran care home. Slowly children started recovering from the illness after enrollment and started living happily with new friends. Our care home environment totally changed their life by providing proper care, food, and healthcare services. Now Shridhar is one of the talented kids of our care home.



Education for a bright future



Bhumika Sunilsingh Rajput belongs to a Middle-Class family and her father was the sole breadwinner. He had taken a truck on loan and used to Drive it for earning. 


