Malnutrition and hunger can lower a child's ability to learn effectively. Many children belonging to underserved communities in and around Belagavi experience high rates of childhood undernutrition, to eradicate the hunger and malnutrition among these children we at Utkarsha Learning Center implemented the daily feeding program in collaboration with Feeding India, A Zomato Give Back.

This daily feeding program has brought a positive transformation among HIV-positive kids and underprivileged children. The number of children coming to the school has gradually increased after the implementation of this daily feeding program.

We express our sincere thanks to Feeding India for their invaluable support. This daily feeding program has attracted the community and encouraged them to enroll their children to Utkarsha school. Now hundreds of underprivileged children are able to access quality education along with nutritious food.





Impact of Daily Feeding Program on Children

HIV reduces the immune power of infected children so they need more care and well balanced nutritional food. The daily feeding program provides quality and nutritional food to these children. It has helped us to improve the nutrition level among children.

Also, the daily feeding program has been benefiting underprivileged children belonging to poor families. The children who suffered from malnutrition and hunger now are getting well balanced nutritional food. And this is a new academic year and we have reopened the school and this daily feeding program has brought more children to school.

Impact

Bhagya Navi is a 7-year-old child, at a very young age her parents left this world due to the deadliest HIV and she became an orphan. There is no one to take care of this little kid and she was unaware of her health condition. Her relatives refused to take care of her. Seriously, we can't even imagine such situations in our life. This kid has suffered a lot and she has been neglected by her relatives.

Bhagya's condition became worse day by day due to the unavailability of proper food, care and health services and she was very weak. Somehow her relatives came to know about Mahesh Foundation and enrolled her in the Ashakiran Care home. We were very shocked when Bhagya was brought to us, she was not even able to stand properly. It took several days for her to recover from the illness and slowly she started adjusting herself to this new environment. The proper provision of nutritional food, healthcare services and care totally changed her life.

But maintaining the health condition of HIV-infected children is a bit difficult as they have low immune power and require special care and mainly healthy nutritional food. And they should be protected from malnutrition. Just like Bhgya, we have hundreds of HIV-infected children with us, who don't have any external support except our care home. It was a bit challenging for us to provide nutritional and healthy meals to these hundreds of children. Feeding India has come forward to support us and help us provide nutritional and healthy meals to children like Bhagya. Now she is leading a healthy life and enjoying the nutritious food provided by Feeding India.

Impact

Shantinath is a 7 year old kid and was born in Machhe village of Belagavi. Every child's childhood means parental care and love, but in the case of this kid, it was painful because this kid lost his parents at an early stage of his childhood. His parents were affected by the deadliest disease due to which they left this world in the middle. Just imagine how the situation of this child was when he lost his loved ones. It was like the sudden snatching of all the happiness from life. After the parent's death, Santinath and his siblings were enrolled in the Hostel. When he tested HIV positive the hostel abandoned the kid and suggested to enroll him in the hostel dedicated to HIV-positive children.

The kid was brought to Mahesh Foundation and enrolled in Ashakiran care home. We still remember the blinking eyes of that little kid when he was brought to us. The kid was not in a condition to walk properly and was so weak. During the initial days handling this little kid was quite difficult for us because he was missing his siblings who were staying away from him. Somehow we managed to handle the kid and provided all the necessary facilities like nutritional food, medicine, quality education and care.

As a result of proper care and the provision of medicine, the child started recovering from his illness and living happily with his new friends. It was a bit difficult for us to provide nutritional food to hundreds of children like Shantinath, then feeding India joined hands with us and started the daily feeding program. Now he is healthy and happily living his life.




Last day of Summer Camp
