#### **OVERVIEW OF THE PROJECT:**

Mahesh Foundation aims to empower underprivileged Women's through skill development by establishing a **Driving School**. This initiative will focus on providing professional driving lessons, road safety education, and essential soft skills to help them secure sustainable employment opportunities. The program also aligns with the growing demand for women drivers in sectors such as public transport, logistics, and private services.

By offering this skill training, the foundation hopes to address both the economic needs of the participants and the social stigma associated with women in traditionally maledominated professions, fostering gender equality.



#### **CURRENT SCENARIO:**

#### **Need Assessment**

In India, especially in rural and semi-urban areas, underprivileged Women's face significant barriers to accessing education and employment. Economic hardships, lack of exposure, and social norms restrict their ability to seek gainful employment. There is a growing demand for skilled female drivers in both public and private sectors, such as ride-sharing platforms, cab services, logistics, and personal transport.



Many of these Women's come from backgrounds where they have limited exposure to vocational training. Learning driving provides them with a life skill that opens doors to secure, well-paying jobs. This project will bridge the gap between the demand for female drivers and the untapped potential of underprivileged Women's.



#### **VISION FOR CHANGE:**

The vision of this project is to:

- Empower underprivileged Women's by providing them with a skill that can offer financial independence and improved livelihoods.
- Break the gender stereotypes surrounding the profession of driving and create a more inclusive workforce.
- Contribute to the broader goal of women's empowerment by enhancing their social and economic status in society.
- Foster confidence, independence, and self-reliance in Women from disadvantaged backgrounds.

#### **TARGET BENEFICIARIES:**

This project will primarily benefit:

• **Underprivileged Women's (aged 18-25)**: The focus will be on Women's from economically weaker sections who have completed basic education but lack access to vocational skills.



- **Dropouts**: Women's who have dropped out of school and are looking for ways to contribute to their family's income.
- **Orphaned or HIV-Affected Women's**: Beneficiaries will include those who are under the care of Mahesh Foundation, particularly those affected by HIV or who have lost parents.

We anticipate enrolling **300 Women's in the first year** of the project, with plans to scale the program in subsequent years.



#### **IMPACT ASSESSMENT:**

The anticipated outcomes of the Driving School project include:

- **Economic Empowerment**: With a driver's license and professional training, the Women's will be able to seek jobs in various sectors, improving their family income and financial independence.
- **Social Empowerment**: The project will break gender norms, helping to build a more inclusive and supportive community for women in unconventional professions.
- **Increased Employability**: Besides driving skills, the program will provide soft skills, communication training, and personality development, making the Women's more competitive in the job market.
- **Improved Self-Esteem**: By mastering a skill associated with mobility and independence, the beneficiaries will experience a boost in self-confidence and dignity.

#### **MONITORING AND EVALUATION OF THE PROJECT:**

The project will be monitored and evaluated at different stages to ensure effectiveness and transparency:



- **Baseline Surveys**: At the beginning of the project, baseline data will be collected on the educational background, socio-economic status, and skills level of the beneficiaries.
- **Monthly Reviews**: A monthly review will assess the progress of each participant, focusing on their driving proficiency, soft skills development, and confidence levels.
- **Skill Testing**: At the end of the course, formal assessments will be conducted to evaluate the Women's' driving abilities, theoretical knowledge of road safety, and communication skills.
- **Job Placement Tracking**: Post-training, the foundation will track the employment status of the beneficiaries for six months to ensure successful placement.
- **Feedback Mechanisms**: Regular feedback from the beneficiaries will be gathered to improve the training modules and ensure that the course meets their expectations.

#### PROJECT IMPLEMENTATION METHODOLOGY:

**Recruitment and Enrollment**: A comprehensive outreach program will be conducted in collaboration with local communities, schools to identify potential beneficiaries. A screening process will ensure that the most deserving candidates are selected.

#### **Training Curriculum:**

- **Driving Skills**: Practical and theoretical training sessions will be conducted by certified driving instructors. Participants will learn driving on various types of vehicles.
- **Road Safety Education**: Emphasis on safe driving practices, traffic rules, and handling emergencies.
- **Soft Skills**: Training in basic communication, customer service, and personality development to prepare them for the job market.
- **Facilities**: The driving school will be equipped with simulators, training vehicles, classrooms, and safety equipment. The infrastructure will include a driving track and classrooms for theoretical lessons.
- **Licensing Support**: Mahesh Foundation will assist the Women's in obtaining their driving licenses upon successful completion of the course.
- **Job Placement Assistance**: The foundation will partner with organizations such as ride-sharing companies, logistics firms, and public transport services to facilitate job placements.
- **Counseling and Mentorship**: Participants will receive mentorship throughout the program to support them in overcoming personal and professional challenges.

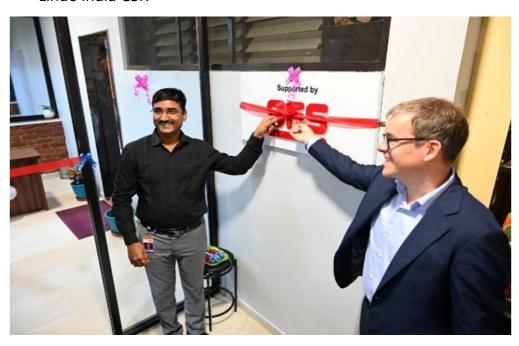
