Education





With the expansion, we have successfully expanded our school's reach in the academic year 2024–25, welcoming more than 1,000 students into our fold. The center now combines strong academics with skill-based learning, ensuring every child receives a holistic education. This growth reflects the deep trust of the community and strengthens our mission of empowering underprivileged children. For many families, the school has become a beacon of hope, nurturing dreams of a brighter and more secure future.

School Events

This year, Utkarsha hosted its much-anticipated Annual Sports Day and Examinations. The events were a celebration of students' academic growth, talents, and sporting spirit. Sports activities encouraged teamwork, discipline, and healthy competition, while exams assessed learning progress. Parents, teachers, and community members actively participated, fostering an atmosphere of encouragement. Such events not only highlight achievements but also boost children's confidence, preparing them for greater challenges ahead.

Teacher Development

Recognizing the vital role of teachers in shaping young minds, we conducted specialized training sessions for our faculty. Education Support in Bengaluru

By addressing challenges like financial barriers and lack of learning support, the program fosters school retention. It also creates a nurturing environment that motivates children to dream beyond limitations. The expansion marks a significant step towards our goal of ensuring education for every child, regardless of geography.

New School Building

Construction work commenced on our new school building, envisioned to benefit more than 2,000 underprivileged children. The modern facility is designed to include spacious classrooms, science and computer labs, libraries, and activity zones. This infrastructure will provide children with the same opportunities and learning environments as any top school. It symbolizes our commitment to equity in education, where no child is left behind. Once complete, the school will stand as a hub for knowledge, innovation, and holistic child development.







Health





The Care Home continued to welcome and support children in need, offering them a safe environment filled with love, care, and essential facilities. Alongside shelter and nutrition, children received dedicated support in education, health, and recreation. Regular life skills and personality development sessions were conducted to help them grow into confident individuals. Emotional well-being was given special focus through counseling and engaging activities. With each child, Ashakiran stands as a symbol of hope and transformation.



It also ensures that blood can be transported under optimal conditions, preserving quality standards. The vehicle makes it possible to conduct more frequent camps across rural and urban areas. This mobile facility strengthens our ability to respond to

emergencies quickly, ultimately saving more lives.






Akka Café
