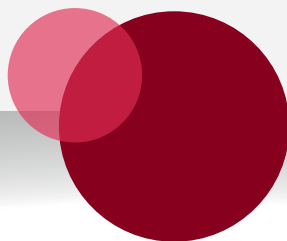

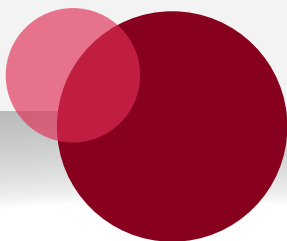

Eradicating Hunger & Malnutrition:

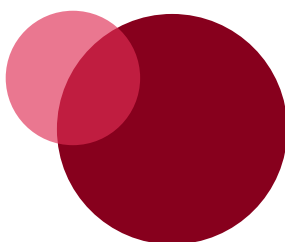
Nutrient-rich meals contribute to the physical growth and development of children. This would result into eradication of hunger and malnutrition among HIV-positive and underprivileged children.

Empowering parents:

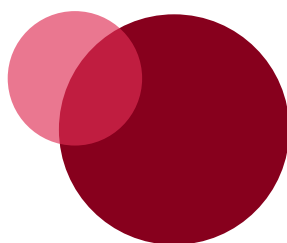
