Number of beneficiaries getting support through the Daily Feeding Program 1500+

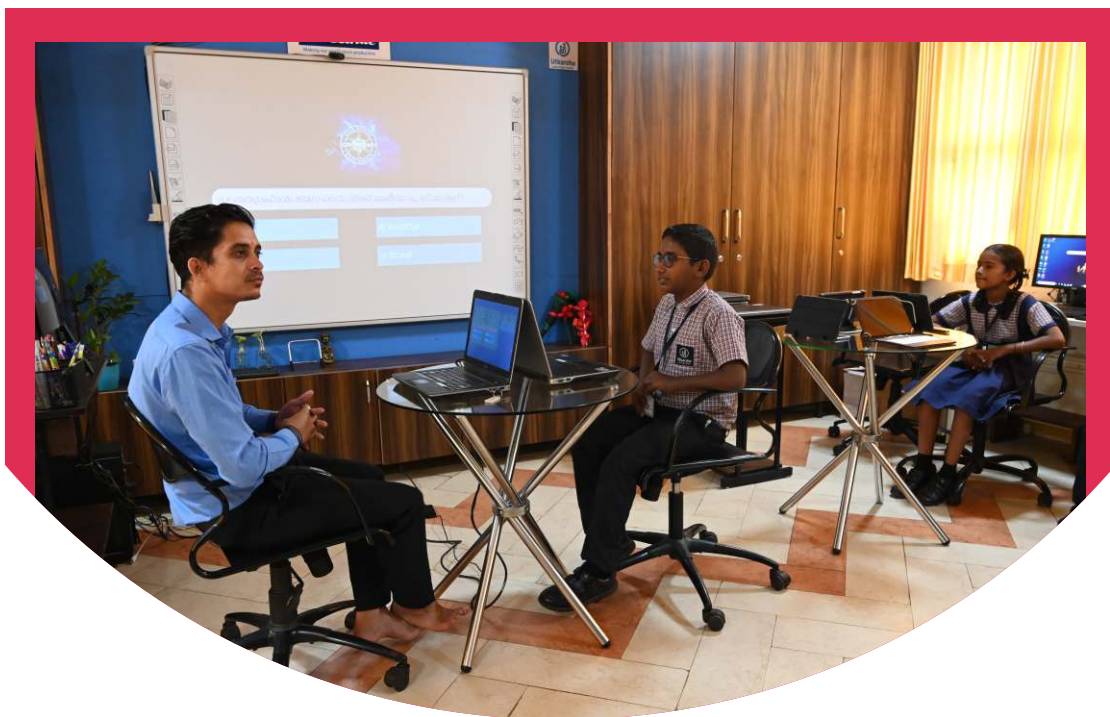
